

COURSE USE GUIDELINES

TRILOGY GOLF CLUB AT LA QUINTA

These guidelines serve as a reference for the use of Trilogy Golf Club at La Quinta (TLQ) facilities. They aim to protect the facilities and promote the health, safety, welfare, and enjoyment of Trilogy® Community Members, their families, guests, daily fee guests, and all other users. TLQ's goal is to provide an enjoyable golf experience. All individuals using TLQ facilities must act in a manner consistent with good taste. TLQ reserves the right to amend these guidelines at its sole discretion without prior notice.

1. GENERAL POLICIES

HOURS OF OPERATION

TLQ facilities operate on schedules established by TLQ. Certain areas may be periodically closed for maintenance and repairs. TLQ reserves the right to close the golf course, Kitchen Ten Eleven, or the Clubhouse at its discretion.

PERSONAL CONDUCT

All individuals must treat golf course personnel with respect and follow their directions. Disrespect, including ordering, abusing, or berating staff, will not be tolerated. Any concerns should be directed to golf course management.

DRESS CODE

Proper golf attire is required at all times:

Men Collared shirts (soft, hard, or mock) with sleeves, slacks, or Bermuda shorts of mid-thigh length. Tank tops, t-shirts, mesh shirts, sweatpants, warm-up suits, blue jeans, swim wear, short shorts, cut-offs, gym shorts, tennis outfits, or other athletic shorts are not permitted.

Women Dresses, skirts, slacks, mid-length shorts, and blouses are acceptable. Halter tops, t-shirts, cut-offs, sweatpants, warm-up suits, blue jeans, swim wear, tennis dresses, short shorts, or other athletic shorts are not permitted.

Golf Shoes Metal spikes are prohibited. Soft spikes or spike-less shoes are required. Tennis shoes or other soft-sole shoes are subject to approval by the golf professional on duty.

Improperly dressed golfers will be asked to change before playing. If in doubt, consult the golf professional before starting play.

COMPLAINTS

All complaints, criticisms, or suggestions regarding TLQ operations or team members must be submitted in writing, signed, and addressed to the Club Manager.

PERSONAL COOLERS

All food and beverages consumed on TLQ premises must be furnished by TLQ unless otherwise permitted. Outside food and beverages will be confiscated, and violations may result in removal or suspension from the facility.

PERSONAL SERVICE

Guests may not request special personal services from TLQ team members or use TLQ furnishings/equipment not ordinarily available to all guests.

PETS

No animals are allowed on golf course property without prior approval from golf course management. Service dogs are permitted but must remain tethered, harnessed, or leashed unless otherwise required by the owner's disability.

PEDESTRIAN AND BICYCLE TRAFFIC

For safety reasons, jogging, bicycling, fishing, and recreational walking are not allowed on the golf course or cart paths.

2. GOLF COURSE RULES & ETIQUETTE

CHECK-IN & PLAY POLICIES

All players must check in with the Golf Shop before using the driving range or golf course.

"Cutting-in" on the course is not permitted.

Players may not start play from residences under any circumstances.

PRACTICE AREAS

Practice is only allowed in designated practice facilities.

The driving range opens 45 minutes before the first tee time and closes one hour before sunset.

Practice balls are for use on the practice facility only and may not be removed or used on the golf course.

GOLF COURSE ETIQUETTE

Enter and exit bunkers at the lowest point and smooth sand with a rake upon leaving.

Repair all ball marks on greens and divots in fairways and rough.

Searching for golf balls other than those played by the group is prohibited.

Each player must have their own set of clubs.

Play must cease if lightning is present. TLQ does not assume responsibility for detecting lightning or warning players.

Twosomes and singles will be grouped with others at the discretion of the Golf Shop.

Singles have no priority and should not expect to play through other groups.

Walking is permitted at the discretion of the Golf Shop.

Music is allowed but must be kept at a reasonable volume.

Comfort stations are available throughout the course. Using other areas for personal needs may result in removal from the course.

PACE OF PLAY

A round must be completed in four (4) hours or less. TLQ team members may assist slow groups:

First Warning Group is asked to improve their pace and given a target.

Second Warning Players must pick up and move into position.

Third Warning The group is removed from the course.

GOLF CARTS

Maximum of two (2) carts per group. Threesomes may have an extra cart; foursomes must share.

Carts must remain at least 30 feet from tee boxes and greens.

Carts must follow directional signage and avoid native landscape areas.

Only licensed drivers aged 16+ may operate carts.

Carts must remain on paths on all Par 3 holes.

Intoxicated persons may not operate carts.

Damages or injuries resulting from golf cart use are the operator's responsibility.

FIVESOMES

Fivesomes are not allowed unless approved by the professional golf team.

FIRST TEE HOST AND PLAYER ASSISTANT

These team members have the authority to enforce TLQ policies.

HOMEOWNER PROPERTY

Players may not enter homeowner or association property for any reason, including retrieving golf balls.

3. GOLF RESERVATIONS & MEMBERSHIP POLICIES

TEE TIME RESERVATIONS

Trilogy Residents May book up to **32 days in advance** and receive a **20% discount** (Monday-Thursday, excluding holidays). Up to three (3) guests may receive the Trilogy Resident Rate.

General Public May book up to 30 days in advance at the posted rate.

Premier, Premier Plus, and Advantage Passholders May book up to **23 days in advance.** Reservations outside this window will be subject to the Trilogy Resident Rate, and passes will not be applicable.

FROST DELAY POLICY

Players should avoid walking or driving on turf during frost delays.

TLQ will provide delay updates via email. Reservations will be honored in their original order.

A modified start (shotgun or altered tee times) may be implemented.

CANCELLATION POLICY

48-hour notice required for cancellations or player count modifications.

No-show penalties may apply.

Refunds are only issued for course closures due to extreme weather (as determined by TLQ). Rain checks may be provided at TLQ's discretion.

4. INCLEMENT WEATHER & COURSE CONDITIONS

Play is at the participant's own risk during inclement weather.

TLQ is not responsible for detecting or warning players of adverse conditions (e.g., lightning, high winds, heavy rain).

The Golf Shop may restrict or suspend play at any time for safety or course protection.

Cart restrictions may be enforced during wet or compromised conditions.

Solo rider carts are not guaranteed and are permitted only at the discretion of the Golf Professional.

The Golf Shop reserves the right to adjust tee times or access based on weather and course conditions.

5. EVENTS & OUTINGS

MEN'S AND WOMEN'S CLUB PLAY

TLQ allocates tee times or shotgun events for Club-sponsored leagues at its discretion, collaborating with groups based on seasonality and demand.

PRIVATE EVENTS & OUTINGS

TLQ may limit tee times and course availability for private events.

Passholder discounts do not apply to private events.
