## LOCAL RULES

- To assist with our Pace of Play, if a player's ball is lost in the native or desert areas surrounding the golf course, the player may drop another ball within two club-lengths from the point of entry, no nearer the hole. One Stroke penalty.
- Drop Areas are located on the green side of holes 3, 7 and 17. If a ball is in or it is known or virtually certain that a ball that has or has not been found is in the penalty area, the player would drop a ball, under penalty of one stroke in the drop area.
- Please keep golf carts on the path on all par 3's and at least 30 yards from all greens and tees.
- Golf Carts may not be driven in the native grass or desert areas.
- Appropriate golf attire must be worn at all times.
- If a ball lies through the green and a sprinkler head within two club-lengths of the putting green and within two club-lengths of the ball intervenes on the line of play between the ball and the hole, the ball may be lifted and dropped at the nearest point to where the ball lay that (a) is not nearer the hole, (b) avoids intervention and (c) is not in a hazard or on a putting green.

## **USGA RULES**

- Penalty Areas are defined by Red or Yellow stakes or lines, and the player may proceed under Rule 17-1.
- Out of Bounds are defined by White stakes or lines, perimeter fences and roadways, and the player may proceed under Rule 18.
- Golfers are responsible for any damage due to an errant golf shot" under the Local rules section, as the last bullet...
