



Showing Interest in Member Clubs

You'll receive email notifications any time that the club page has been updated or when a new Discussion has been posted. For Club Leaders, encouraging your club's Members and potential Members to show interest in your club page allows you to stay connected with them.



How to Show Interest in A Member Club

1. First, you'll log in to MTL and navigate to the Clubs section of the site, highlighted in yellow.





2. Click on the Member-led Club you're interested in and you'll be taken to that club's page where you can read its Description, see its Upcoming Events, Discussion Posts and FAQs.

To show your interest in the club and to begin receiving notifications each time the page is updated or a Discussion is posted, click on the button which says **Interested** on the right-hand side of the page (or just under the club's name on mobile).



- Now the Interested button on that club's page will be replaced with an **Unfollow** button, which you may do at any time.

If you navigate back to the main Clubs section on MTL, and select **My Member Clubs**, all clubs you've chosen to be interested in will show up right here for quick access. You'll also see that same green banner on clubs you've shown interest in under **All Member Clubs**.



- As long as you've checked the box next to **Clubs I'm Following** in your Notification Settings, you'll now begin to receive email notifications any time the club page is updated or a new Discussion has been posted and commented on, keeping you up-to-date on Club happenings!

Be sure to do this for as many or as little clubs as you'd like to continue to personalize your MTL experience!
